**Job Description:** **Maintenance Technician**

**Job Summary:** Responsible for meeting customer needs by meeting daily job or work schedule in timely manner and in accordance to OSHA standards.

- Maintaining, diagnosing and repairing or replacing faulty mechanical, hydraulic, pneumatic components of machines and equipment.
- General upkeep and maintenance of entire facility.
- Install repairs and performs maintenance on welding machines, plasma machines, welding guns.
- Diagnosing malfunctioning apparatus such as motors and lighting fixtures and replacing damaged or broken wires or cables.
- Working with others to test, troubleshoot and diagnose malfunctions on electrical and mechanical equipment and machines and test operation following repair.
- Maintaining and completing routine maintenance schedules on equipment.
- Understanding and following Lockout/Tagout procedures.
- Assisting with continuous improvement and lean initiatives by following process flow, remaining flexible to complete tasks as part of the team, maintaining a clean work environment and offering suggestions for improvements.

**Tools Used:** Hand power and machine tools, clamps, jigs, grinder, cutting torch, overhead hoists, forklifts, handcarts, measuring devices, etc.

**Safety Equipment:** Safety glasses, safety steel toe shoes, ear plugs, face shield, goggles, gloves, dust masks, aprons, etc.

**Environment:** Both office and production floor. Production floor is a heavy industrial atmosphere including exposure to electrical and mechanical hazards, grease, heat, humidity, fumes/odors, mists, dust, sparks, occasionally cramped quarters and occasional heights.

**Job Requirements:**

- 3 years experience in plant maintenance as a technician.
- Valid driver's license.
- Minimum of two years maintenance experience with knowledge of mechanical machinery, electrical systems, pneumatics, air compressor systems and welding machines.
- Proficient use of hand and power tools.
- Strong troubleshooting skills.
- Good verbal/written communication skills (English/Spanish bi-lingual), ability to comprehend and follow directions, perform basic math and display good time management.

- Ability to work on concrete in a variety of positions including but not limited to kneeling, crouching, bending, twisting, turning and occasionally climbing.
- Ability to manually move product and materials up to 50 lbs. through occasional heavy physical exertion, including but not limited to lifting, carrying, pushing, pulling and bending. Using overhead hoists requires ability to push and pull up to 100 lbs.
- Must be able to work on various projects and rotate jobs to meet work schedule, production needs or to meet any safety recommendations.
- Must work in safe manner following safety procedures, including wearing Personal Protection Equipment to complete tasks and communicating hazards to co-workers and management.
